This beautiful home was built in 1902 on Tesoro Rancho. The owner was one of the founders of Placentia. They organized the Placentia National Bank, one of the packing houses, and the Placentia water tower. What was the name of the owner of this home and what is the address?

This family received a land grant from Mexico and called their home Rancho San Juan Cajon de Santa Ana. Their adobe home was located on Crowther Avenue and Porter Avenue, west of Kraemer Boulevard. This is where you can find a plaque dedicated to this family. What was the family's name?
